What is an Altered Book?

An “altered book” is a book, old or new, that has been transformed by creative means into a work of art. Creating altered books may be as simple as adding a drawing or text to a page, or as complex as creating an intricate book sculpture.

Entry Specifications:

The competition is open to anyone 18 years of age or over. Pratt staff members may participate in a separate category from the public. Each entry must be accompanied by a completed and signed registration form.

There are no rules about how to alter your book – you can add to, delete from, cut up, collage, reconfigure the book – in short, whatever comes to mind. Entries must not be excessive in size or weight for display purposes and be suitable for family viewing.

Books may come from any source. Just please, do not use a library book!

Artists may only submit one entry.

Judging: Entries will be judged by a panel of distinguished local artists. All entries will be assigned a number upon submission. Artists' names will not be displayed during the judging process. The winner(s) will be announced on Monday, August 12 @ 7 pm. Prizes will be awarded. Entries will be on display in the branch during the months of August & September.
